Pursuant to Act 267 of 1976 (Michigan Open Meetings Act)

Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPC) were established under the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986.

The role of the LEPC is to form partnerships between government and industries as a resource for enhancing hazardous materials preparedness.

The Gratiot County LEPC was established to:

- **Provide, under community-right-to-know requirements, a forum for the public to access local hazardous chemical information.**
- **Develop and maintain the county Emergency Operations Plan and review the plan at least annually.**
- **Manage the collection, storage and dissemination of data required to implement these tasks.**
- **Sustain or build capabilities based upon Emergency Management principles**
