

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CITY OF ALMA MILLAGE PROPOSITION</b></p> <p>Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in the City of Alma, County of Gratiot, State of Michigan, be increased by 3.5 mills (\$3.50 on each \$1,000.00) on state taxable value for a period of six years, 2023 through 2028, inclusive, for the rehabilitation, repair and maintenance of public streets and ancillary public infrastructure within the corporate limits of the City of Alma? The amount of revenue the City of Alma will collect if this millage is approved and levied by the City in the first year is estimated to be \$644,000. This proposal is for a new additional millage, due to the expiration of the millage for rehabilitation, repair and maintenance of public streets and ancillary public infrastructure previously passed by the voters of the City of Alma in 2016. The revenue generated from this millage, if the proposal is passed, will be disbursed to the City of Alma.</p>
